

The Water & Natural Resources Tour will explore "Big Sky Country" and Yellowstone National Park this year, destinations not previously visited during the annual tour.

Organized by the Nebraska Water Center and Central Nebraska Public Power and Irrigation District, the 48th annual tour runs Sept. 15-19 and begins and ends in Billings, MT.

In addition to a full day in Yellowstone Park and many other stops, the tour will visit historic Buffalo Bill Dam near Cody, WY, the Big Sky ski area, Missouri Headwaters State Park, and the Gallatin and Yellowstone River watersheds. Presenters will discuss topics and issues related to water and natural resources and how the resources are managed and shared among the many - and often competing - uses for the supply.
